**KICKBALL CAMP (1-3)**

Campers will form friendships and learn the basics and rules of playing kickball. Sportsmanship and team comradery will be emphasized for these beginners.

**YOGA AND MORE (K-2)**

In this playful yoga camp, students will learn yoga poses, breathing, and relaxation exercises which cultivate a calm mind, increase strength and flexibility, improve gross and fine motor skills, improve concentration, and give the campers the tools to manage stress.

**BASKETBALL CAMP (5-8) (6-8)**

This camp will provide a positive and enjoyable learning environment with individual instruction in skills such as shooting, passing, ball handling, offense, and defense. Games will be played emphasizing teamwork and sportsmanship.

**INDOOR SOCCER CAMP (3-8) (6-8)**

Warm up with basic soccer skills such as dribbling, passing, shooting, and ball-control then play sided games to gain confidence with the ball.

**BASEBALL CAMP (6-8)**

*"Take me out to the ballgame!"*

Students will learn and practice the following skills; fielding, base running, hitting, and pitching. Student will show off these skills as they compete with one another in a game.



**ARTS & CRAFTS**

**DRAWING MAGIC (K-2)**

Learn how to draw a vase of flowers, animals, and a landscape by using simple shapes. After outlining with a Sharpie Marker, the young artists will learn how to properly color and learn the techniques of blending and shading with their crayons.

**PASTEL PIZZAZZ (3-5) (6-8)**

Challenge your creativity with a beautiful array of colorful oil pastels. This type of art allows you to experiment with blending and over-lapping of colors that create new colors. Possible themes may include a beach scene, lighthouse, or animal of the season.

**A SPLASH OF WATERCOLORS (6-8)**

Enhance your creativity through the art of watercolors. Learn different techniques (blending and shading) and develop your "OWN" style while showcasing your painting skills. Possible paintings could include a beach scene, underwater scene, a floral vase, and more.

**CARTOONING (6-8)**

Learn a step-by-step process on how to create cartooning characters using geometric shapes. Students will learn the importance of outlining their drawings, as well as, color placement with each character they create. Possible subjects can be Mickey and Minnie Mouse, Angry Birds, and Tom and Jerry.

## CAMP PROGRAMS

### **CAMP CURIOSITY (PREK-2)**

Come explore Camp Curiosity for our early childhood learners. While camping students will paint with marshmallows, go fishing, build a pretend fire, go animal tracking, build tents, make and use smores for a STREAM activity, and more! This camp will keep little learners engaged and active during the summer, all while having fun!

### **SUNSATONAL SUMMER SCIENCE (K-2)**

Covid - 19 has had us trapped inside for far too long! Join a visiting veteran first grade teacher for a week of exploring the fascinating world found outside... Insects? Weather? Plants? You'll have to sign up to find out. I can't wait to meet our future scientists!

### **SUPER SCIENCE CLUB (K-2)**

Learn about science experiments that you can do at home with things you can find around your house. Discover tricks that will surprise your family. Together we will explore simple activities that teach science concepts and are fun at the same time. You'll even learn how to write a lab report.

### **MUSICIANS' WORKSHOP (1-3)**

In this workshop, students will learn about and play the djembe, steel drum, and xylophone in a relaxing and step-by-step manner. In addition, we will share multicultural music and how it relates to each instrument.

### **THE MAGICAL BOOK FACTORY (1-3)**

Students will listen to, read, and explore different patterns and styles found in children's literature. Each day students will use these models to write their own stories and creatively construct and publish a book.

### **READING ROCKETS (1-3)**

Let's keep the reading going! This reading enrichment program will provide a variety of reading experiences and practice in poetry, book reading, reader's theater, and non-fiction texts. This camp is a must for children who love to read.

### **READING REINFORCERS (1-3)**

This summer camp is perfect for strengthening students' reading skills. Reading strategies will be reviewed to help children become better readers through books and tips for improvement.

### **MAKERSPACE (1-5)**

Student driven learning will be collaborative and creative while learning how to design, illustrate, build, and explore in a STEAM setting.

### **CODING QUEST (3-5)**

Participants will be learning the basics of coding-taking and giving directions, learning to think ahead, and learning perseverance. In this program, participants will work with block coding through Scratch Jr. and work on making games and videos. By completing this camp, participants will build a knowledge base of how websites, robots, videos games, and apps work.

### **STORYTIME WRITING WORKSHOP (3-5)**

Participants will learn the process of story writing by creating relatable characters and setting a scene all while developing a well-thought out and engaging storyline. During this process, they will also be building knowledge in story plot skills, organizing information and ideas, and fine-tuning grammar skills. At the end, participants will read their completed stories to the group to show what amazing writers they have become!

### **GET CREATIVE WITH WORDS AND SCIENCE (3-5)**

Two for one deal! This summer camp involves the integration of the scientific method and conducting hands-on science experiments with creative writing including the daily use of journal keeping, poetry, and illustrating and diagramming ideas and concepts through art.



### **GAME SHOW MANIA (3-5)**

Get ready for a week of Game Show Mania! Fun themes such as: outer space, under the sea, positivity, and character building will be explored. The week will end with a Marvel Superhero Day! Each day one of the themes will be implemented through a popular game show.

### **YESTERGAMES (3-5) (4-8)**

Go back into time and have some old-fashioned fun! Learn and play games such as Spud, Box Ball, Capture the Flag, Whiffle Ball, and more. Different games will be played each day.

### **ROBOTICS CAMP (5-8)**

During Robotics Camp the students will be introduced to and work with three Cozmo Robots. The Cozmo Robot is a great way to get students interested in coding. Cozmo's personality is cute and friendly, appealing to all ages. At the basic level, students will learn about robots; taking care of them, interacting with them, and how coding controls everything about them. Students can explore the possibilities and limitations of robots. You'll discover that Cozmo is actually very sophisticated, both in its software and hardware.

### **THEATRE BLITZ (5-8)**

Spend a fun-filled week on stage and behind the scenes. During this week, we will be practicing and applying the skills and talents necessary to put on a performance. The week will culminate with a short skit on Thursday. We will have a great time showing everyone all the world can be our stage.

### **3D PRINTING FUN (5-8)**

During our 3-D printing camp, students will learn all the ins-and-outs of 3D printing. 3D printing offers students the ability to experience their projects from the model stage to actual creation of the model. This creates both excitement and a better understanding of the design process. Students will gain hands-on experience from conception to creation. Each student will leave camp at the end of the week with a 3D creation to take home.
